Android Mobile App

We have completed the workshop application for Android and are now working on other features of the application including job bookings, sales orders, add to bucket etc.

iOS Stock Take

We have finished developing a single stocktake function for iOS and currently working on a batch stock take function for both iOS and Android devices with iOS being the first priority.

Yamaha Integration

We have now completed the Yamaha integration and waiting on testing by Yamaha prior to its release. This will be of great benefit to numerous customers we have who are Yamaha dealers.

Staff Productivity Dashboard

We are currently working with several customers to produce a substantial staff productivity dashboard and reporting which will also include graphs and the ability to include incentives for staff who meet targets.

Podium Integration

We are currently working on an integration with Podium, which provides advanced SMS and CRM capabilities.

New Stihl Integration

AM-Win has been selected as one of only a few organisations in Australia to be involved in their new pilot program to integrate our DMS software directly into Stihl via an API interface.







Part numbers that are longer than 20 characters

If you are having trouble entering stock codes into the stock master file due to the code being too long. You can enter the full stock code into the Purchase Description.

Our development team will be modifying this for a more efficient way.



Changing the payment method

If you would like to change the payment method for a particular invoice.

Simply go into the Enquiry menu and select the Payment Register. Right click on the payment, select "Change payment method" and choose new payment method from list.



Lightning Payroll: Backing up and Quarantine

Since Lightning Payroll is a desktop application, the data is safely stored in your own computer. We recommend you make yourself familiar with the backup features in the program.

Tech News - Google's new way to search

Google has announced two new ways to search online using Al.

"Radically more helpful" is what Google is saying about their new features to search anything online.

Google are quietly testing a new and much more advanced way for mobile users to search information on their mobile screens.

They call it Circle to Search, just as the name suggests, users will simply circle, highlight or simply scribble in anyway on an image and by using the new AI technology built into their phones, can bring up information relevant from Google.

Additionally, users can simply point their mobile phones towards the subject of interest, to take a photo (or they can simply upload an image from their phone).

By using the Google application, the user can ask a question to get the information.

An example given by Google was looking at a board game and asked how the game was played.

These features will be showcased in the Galaxy 24 smartphone lineup as well as other Android smartphones.

"We have only scratched the surface" they stated in their press release.

Google, Samsung and countless more technology companies are racing to expand their horizons on AI and to get it released to the public.

Since the release of ChatGPT, a revolutionary piece of software released by Microsoft that was launched in November 2022. This was found more superior to a standard Google search and in doing so Google has pushed into integrating AI into most of its products.

This is expected to bring up to \$4.4 Trillion annually.

Since the release of ChatGPT, Microsoft has been considered the most valuable company in the world, over taking Apple in January 2024.



Scam Alert - Australia Post

One of the most common and concerning scams going around at the moment are emails and SMS messages from scammers who appear to be from Australia Post.

These are messages regarding their couriers attempting to deliver your package to the address provided, but no one was there to collect it.

Or they may say that the delivery address was invalid and they request you update your address by clicking on the link provided.

Please be advised:


Australia Post will never contact you via call, text or email regarding personal or financial information.

Which includes any passwords, credit card details or account details.

They will not contact you to request payment or to click an email link to print off a label to redeem your package. Please refer to the image as seen on the Australia Post website. It is advised on their website, that once you select

"schedule Re-Delivery" the link will lead to a site that is designed to steal your personal information.

Stage 3 tax cuts for lower-income earners.

Australia prime minister Anthony Albanese strongly indicates beneficial tax cuts for lower-income earners.

The labour government's reform of the stage 3 tax cuts signifies an alteration of the original tax cut package, which was created in 2019 under the Morrison government.

The heavy weighting of the original package towards those on the highest incomes was considered a difficult to rationalise the economic environment of this time.

Given the irregular impact of the cost of living on low and middle-income earners, the variation

is seen as a way to provide financial relief for taxpayers.

From July 1 2024, the 37 per cent marginal tax rate was to be abolished for those earning more than \$120,000 a year, and the 32.5 per cent tax rate was to be reduced to 30 per cent for people earning between \$45,000 and \$200,000. This would have meant that there would be a single 30% tax bracket for everyone earning between \$45,000 and \$200,000. For earnings above \$200,000, the current 45% tax rate would be retained.

But as originally designed, the tax cuts delivered most of the benefit to those on high incomes. So, nothing at all for people earning \$45,000, only \$875 for people earning \$80,000 but a whopping \$9,075 for people earning \$200,000

Prime minister Anthony Albanese has released the following proposed changes:

- A cut in the 19% tax rate to 16%. Which will save \$804 for those on taxable incomes of \$45,000.
- A cut in the 32.5% tax rate to 30% for incomes between \$45,000 and \$135,000.
- Keeping the 37 per cent rate but increasing the threshold for it to apply to \$135,000.
- Keeping the current 45% tax rate but increasing the threshold to \$190,000. Which is \$10,000 less than the original design.

Focusing on the low and middle income taxpayers; The savings will be able to be issued more broadly as the tax cuts package remain the same overall.

Recipe – Roasted Pumpkin Salad with Honey and Balsamic Dressing



INGREDIENTS:

- 1.75kg butternut pumpkin, deseeded, cut into 2cm-thick pieces
- Olive oil cooking spray
- ½ cup pine nuts
- 200g baby spinach

Honey and Balsamic dressing:

- ½ cup honey
- 2 tbsp Balsamic Vinegar
- 1 tbsp olive oil

METHOD

Step 1

Preheat oven to 250°C. Line 2 baking trays with baking paper. Place pumpkin_in a single layer on trays. Spray with oil_and turn to coat. Season with salt and pepper. Roast pumpkin, turning once, for 20 minutes or until golden and tender. Set aside to cool to room temperature.

Step 2

Meanwhile, heat a small, non-stick frying pan over medium heat. Add pine nuts. Cook, stirring for 3 minutes or until golden.

Step 3

Make honey and balsamic dressing:

combine honey, vinegar and oil in a screw top jar. Secure lid and shake to combine. Remove lid. Microwave on HIGH (100%) for 10 seconds or until honey is melted. Replace lid. Shake until well combined.

Step 4

Place spinach and pumpkin in a large bowl. Sprinkle with pine nuts. Drizzle with dressing. Season with salt and pepper. Serve.



Croissant Sausage Rolls



INGREDIENTS:

- 250g beef mince
- 250g beef sausages, casings removed
- 35g (1/2 cup) fresh breadcrumbs
- 1 egg, lightly whisked
- 3 tbs tomato sauce, plus extra, to serve
- 1/2 tsp Tuscan seasoning
- 3 sheets puff pastry, just thawed
- 1 egg yolk, lightly whisked

METHOD

Step 1

Preheat oven to 220C/200C fan forced. Line a baking tray with baking paper.

Step 2

Place beef mince, sausage, breadcrumbs, egg, tomato sauce and seasoning in a bowl. Stir until well-combined.

Step 3

Cut each sheet of pastry diagonally into 4 triangles. Spoon the beef mixture into a piping bag.

Step 4

Pipe mixture along the longest edge of each pastry triangle. Brush exposed pastry with a little egg. Roll up pastry from the longest edge to enclose mixture and form a croissant shape. Place on the prepared tray and brush with egg. Repeat with remaining mixture, pastry and egg.

Step 5

Bake for 30-35 minutes or until puffed and golden.

Step 6

Serve with extra tomato sauce.
